2014 Scholarship Application for Accredited Higher Learning The Green Beret Foundation and PNC Foundation

The following material includes information relating to the Green Beret Foundation Scholarship Program including eligibility, application requirements and a scholarship application form.

Purpose:

To provide educational scholarships to eligible students within the Special Forces Community seeking higher education.

General Information:

The Green Beret Foundation is a 501c3 benevolent organization not associated with the military services.

This Green Beret Foundation Scholarship Program is exclusively for dependents of a U.S. Army Special Forces Qualified Soldier or a Special Forces Qualified Soldier.

Scholarship funds can be used for tuition, books, incidental fees, room and board, and other direct associated costs of higher education, excluding transportation.

This scholarship covers educational costs associated to an accredited higher learning institution at the in-state fee level.

Payment will be made directly to the University.

Eligibility:

Applicant must be a dependent of a U.S. Army Special Forces Qualified Soldier or a Special Forces Qualified Soldier. The applicant must also either be an incoming freshman or a senior in Fall 2014.

Eligibility is determined by DD214, University Acceptance Letter, and/or proof of petition to graduate from the university (Seniors) Fall 2014 or Spring 2015.

The applicant must have been accepted by, or already attending, an accredited college, university, or vocational institution.

The following items are required for an application to be considered:

- Applicant must provide a DD214 and/or accompanied by orders reflecting Special Forces Qualification of father to be submitted with scholarship application.
- Applicant's most recent transcripts, SAT scores, and/or other evidence of scholastic achievement (minimum GPA 2.5).
- Copy of accredited university's acceptance letter.
- Applicant must submit a personal statement essay (500-1000 words) explaining need, use of scholarship, how this scholarship will impact you and how your experiences or your family member's experiences in the Special Forces have affected you.
- Reference letter(s) from a teacher, counselor, and/or other evidence of scholastic achievement.
- One (1) page resume listing extracurricular activities, honors, employment, community service and special skills.
- Recommended: A recent photograph suitable for publication; i.e., a cap and gown picture, or other professional quality and professionally dressed photograph to be published in the GBF's newsletter.
- Mail completed application packet to the Green Beret Foundation. Must be received NLT 01 JUN 2014.

Awarded applicants:

Applicants who are awarded a GBF scholarship must maintain no less than a 2.5 semester GPA and a 2.65 yearly cumulative GPA. Upon the completion of each school year, the student must submit a 500 word essay on their past year's experiences and how their education has enriched their life.
